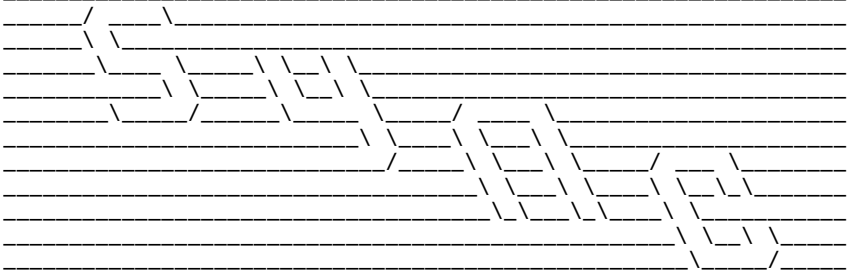

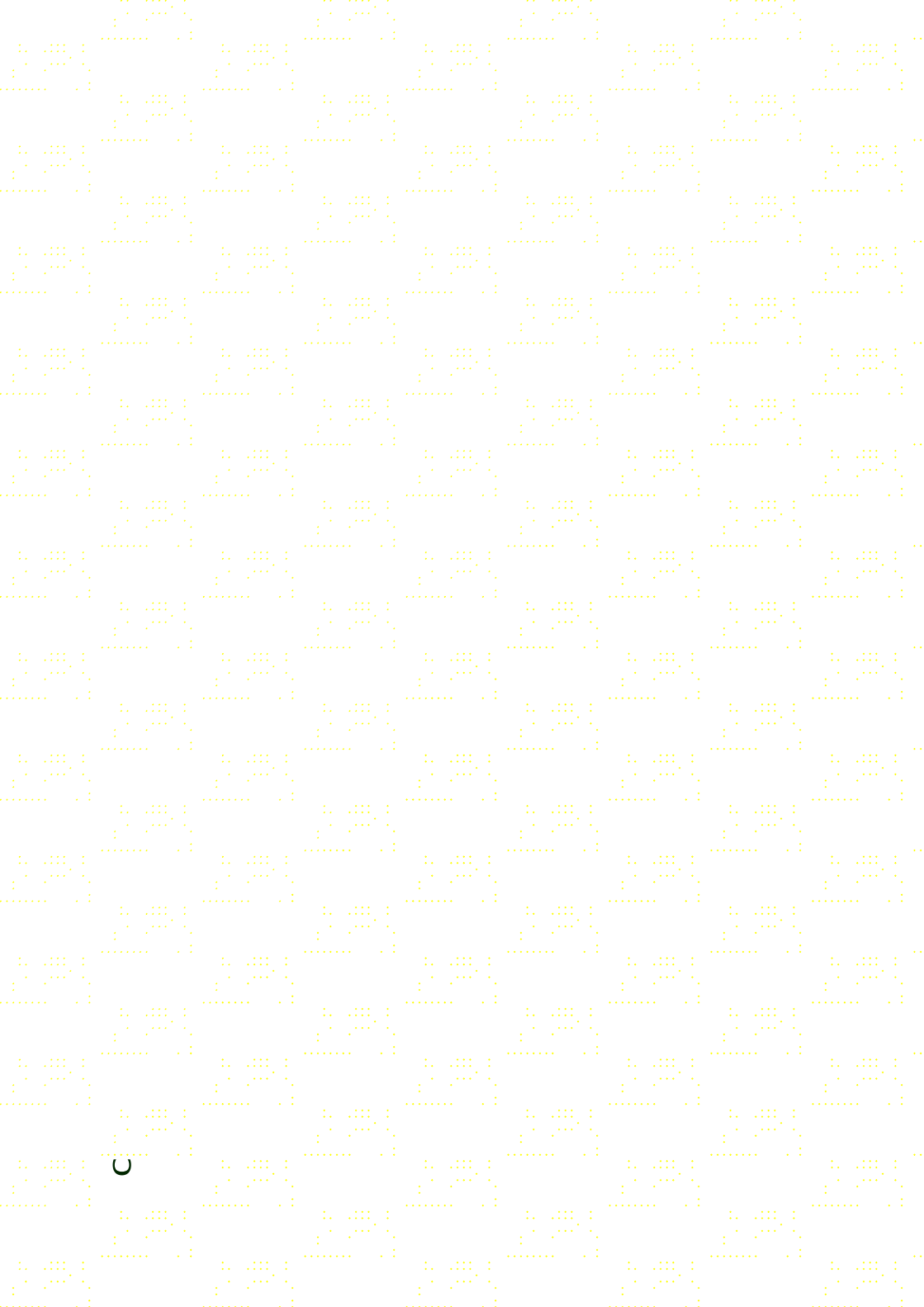

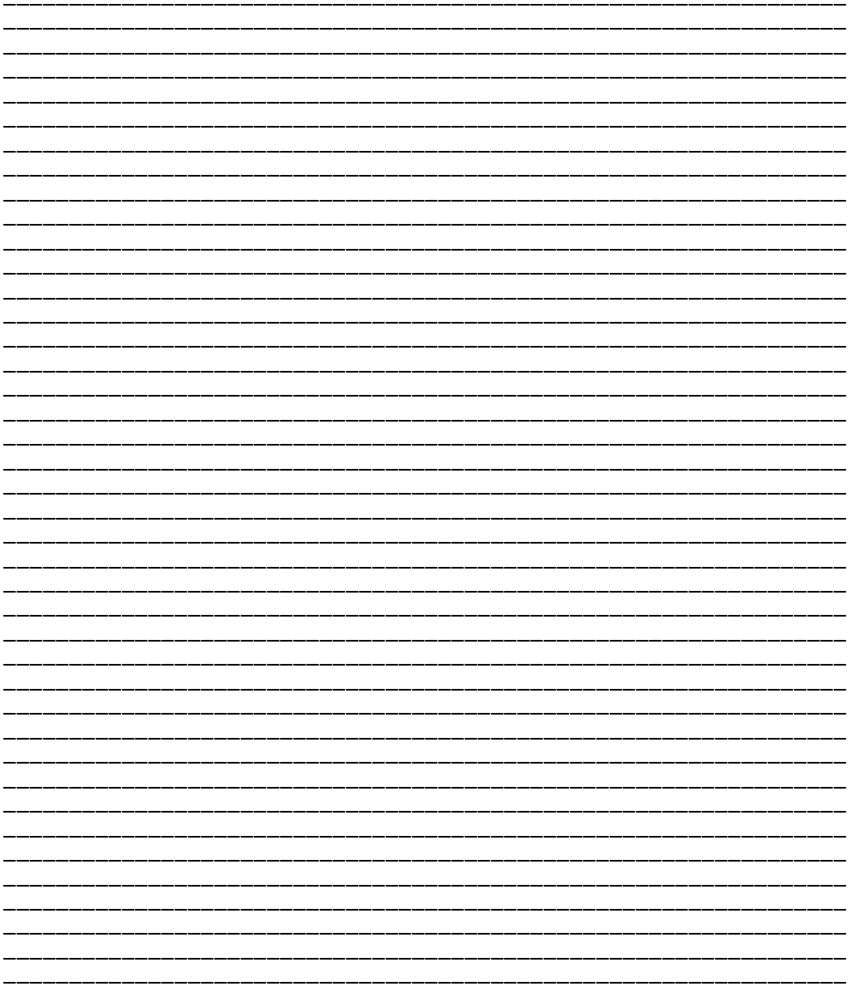
"Document Colour Tracking Dots, or yellow dots, are small systematic dots which encode information about the printer and/or the printout itself. This process is integrated in almost every commercial colour laser printer. This means that almost every printout contains coded information about the source device, such as the serial number."

The paper sheets of this issue contain 3 different tracking dot patterns.

Sheet A: All dots filled. Use this page as a ground layer to render printouts anonymous. (anon)

Sheet B: No dots filled. Use this page to document the pattern of a color laser printer. (analog)

Sheet C: Custom pattern. This page contains information that is retraceable by myself. However, it only works while staying digital and will be obfuscated once printed out and overlaid with new dots. (digital)
